#### **Ticket price**

Grandstand - \$15pp

General Admission - \$10pp

***Disability tickets and groups of 10 or more are available via box office only***

**Tickets must be presented at the gate to gain access to the venue**

**Gates Open:** 12:30pm

**Preliminary Game:** 1:00pm – Between to local teams

**Main game:** 3:00pm

**Gates Close:** 5:00pm

### FAQ's

#### **How do I make group ticket bookings?**

If you require more than 10 tickets, you will need to contact the box office on 4972 2822 or come in

Maximum of 100 tickets at a time per person

#### **Are tickets available at the Gate?**

Provided an event is not sold out beforehand, tickets will be available for purchase at the venue on an event day.

#### **How are the rows numbered?**

Row A is located at ground level, and then work backwards.

#### **Pass outs:**

Yes – We will issue wrist bands as a pass out

**Entrance:** Through Junior fields

**Disabled Entrance:** Dan Murphy's Side

#### **Parking**

Limited parking at the event. A park and ride bus service will be available. All patrons can use the free service with any tickets. Locations TBC

Disabled parking will be onsite through the dan murphy's site

**Taxi Rank:**

Please keep an eye on our Facebook event for taxi drop off zones

**Animals:**

No animals are allowed in the venue

**Can I bring my child's stroller into the Stadium?**

Strollers are allowed if a child is in them

**Can I bring a picnic rug?**

Picnic blankets are permitted however it may be tight if lots of people bring rugs

**Can I bring fold up chairs?**

Fold up chairs are permitted at the event

**Food and Drinks**

No BYO alcohol

No BYO food/ drinks

No Glass

Food vendors, canteens and bars will operate on site

**Can I bring in my camera?**

Cameras will be allowed however checked by security

**Can I bring my mobility scooter in?**

Mobility scooters (not a golf buggy or similar) are allowed into the stadium seating area. They are permitted only in the disabled seating areas in the venue facing the field of play. Patrons must sit on the vehicle if allocated a space in these areas. Patrons are advised to pre-purchase tickets and advise the ticketing agent that a mobility scooter will be utilised. Scooters may also be lodged with a cloaking room. The Venue Management decision will be final in determining if the scooter may be in the seating areas or cloaked. **Is there a drop off point for disabled patrons arriving by car?**

A drop off point will be available however not confirmed, please keep an eye out on our Facebook page

**Do you have EFTPOS facilities?**

No – cash only

**Do you have First Aid facilities?**

First Aid will be located inside the venue, on both sides of the field

**Are my seats under cover?**

Only seating in the main grandstand is covered. Due to the open plan design of the stadium, there can be no guarantees that you will remain dry should rain and wind occur, regardless of your seating location. The dripline (where the edge of the roof lies) is between rows 10 to 15.

**Do you sell merchandise on event days?**

Merch will be available on the day

**Where can I go to collect lost property?**

Please see staff at the canteen to the right of the grandstand for all lost property.

**Can I smoke inside the venue?**

Marley Brown Oval is a no smoking venue. Smoking is only permitted in areas 4 metres from any gate or door.
