AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

1. You must be 16+ years of age.
2. Complete the Audition Application gladstoneentertainment.com/legally-blonde-the-musical. please note you need to complete no later than 3 working days prior to your selected audition date for scheduling. Once your paperwork has been received you will be contacted with an audition date and time.
3. If you have any issues completing the online application please email geccrsvp@gladstone.qld.gov.au with your contact details and we will send you audition application details.
4. You will need to sing a verse and a chorus from a musical (not Legally Blonde)
5. You will need to provide either sheet music or an instrumental backing track (please bring own digital device)
6. Prepare and perform a short monologue from a musical (not Legally Blonde) 1-2 minutes
7. Arrive 15 minutes before your allocated audition time.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PRINCIPAL CALL BACKS

If you are successful in being short listed for a Principal Role, please note the following:

1. You will be required to sing a section from the score of the character chosen by our Creative Crew, alongside the pianist.
2. You will be required to read and perform a section of script provided by our Creative Crew.

CHOREOGRAPHED DANCE SESSIONS

Previously we have asked applicants to prepare a dance, song and monologue for their initial audition, however this year we will be holding two choreographed sessions in place of individual dance auditions.

There will be a beginners/ Intermediate and an Intermediate/advanced session held on the morning of call backs, those who have been short listed for a principal role will remain after the choreographed session for their call back session.
